I chose to write about Edward Snowden. I discovered him and his story thanks to a movie directed by Oliver Stone in 2016.

Advanced level

I would like to write about a woman who is not very famous, but who is a true heroine to me : Jane Addams. She has done a lot for women, but also for children and immigrants. Let me tell you about her.

Jane Addams was born in 1860 in the United States. She was from a very rich and influential family. At age 27, she visited a house for the poor in England. She was really impressed and she tried to create the same in Chicago. It was a real success. She helped not only the poor, but also the children and the immigrants.

She was also a committed peace activist, especially during World War I, and that's why she won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1931. She was also a pioneer of women's suffrage. She taught women that they could be more than just mothers and housewives, and that they could play a part in society.

Jane Addams died in 1934 at the age of 74.

I chose her as my personal real-life heroine, mostly because there are not many women who are remembered, and because I believe it's important that women can be regarded as role models, too. Also, I feel concerned by what she fought against : child labor, exploitation of the poor, oppression of women, war... Her causes were always noble and she did a lot to promote them. I'm still very young, but she inspires me and she gives me the will to stand up for what is right.
