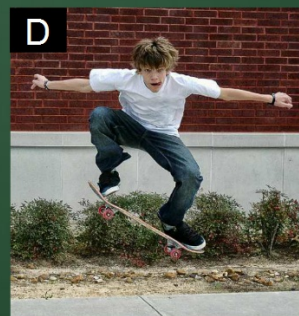
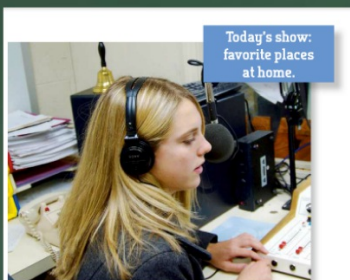

Il y a = there is / are

- suivi du singulier -> there **is**
exemple : In my town, there is a cinema.
- suivi du pluriel -> there **are**
exemple : There are shops, restaurants and hotels.

Il n'y a pas

- There is/are **no** + nom
ex : There is no swimming-pool in my city. There are no shops in my street.
- There **isn't/aren't any** + nom
ex : There isn't any bar in my neighbourhood.

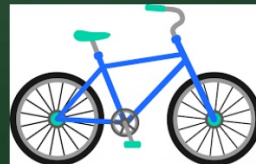
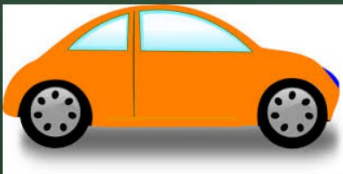
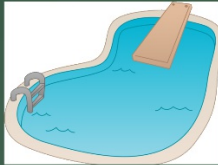
Est-ce qu'il y a ?

- suivi du singulier -> **is there (any) ... ?**
exemple : Is there a supermarket in your town ?
- suivi du pluriel -> **are there (any) ... ?**
exemple : Are there any tigers in this zoo ?

Il y avait

- There **was** (singulier) / **were** (pluriel)
ex : There was a stadium there in 1995.
There were sweets and cakes : it was an awesome birthday !
